### Proposition 65 Declaration

California Proposition 65 (also known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) refers to the California legislation that was intended to ensure that California's State drinking water was free from sources of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

An exemption from the warning label requirement is provided by the Act when it can be demonstrated that product exposure is at or below "safe harbor levels", namely that the levels pose no significant risk of cancer or birth defects/reproductive toxicity.
